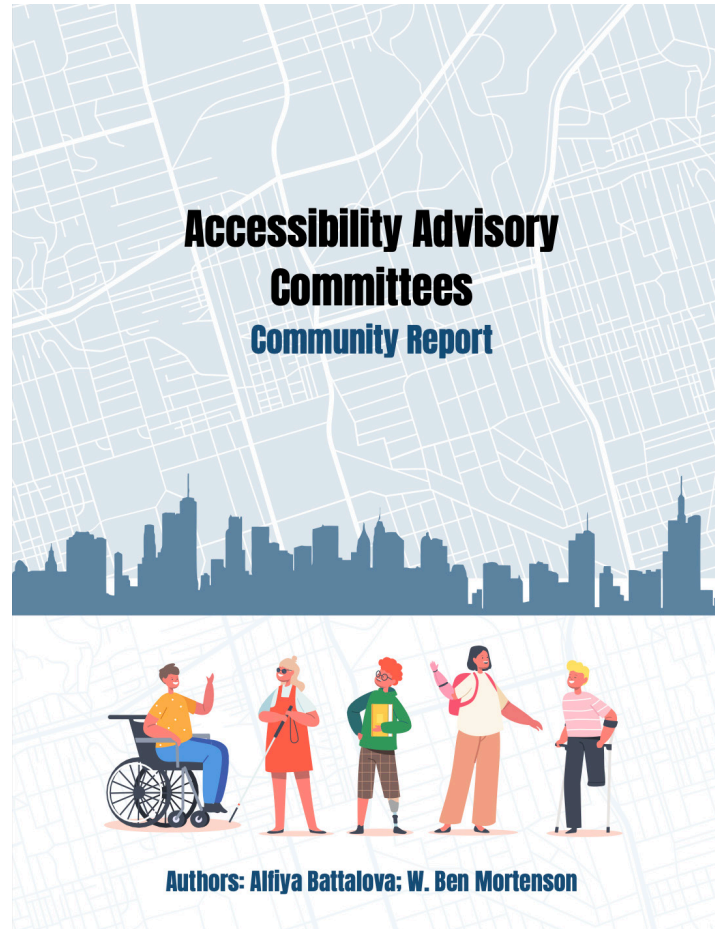

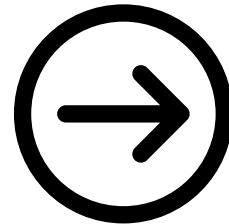
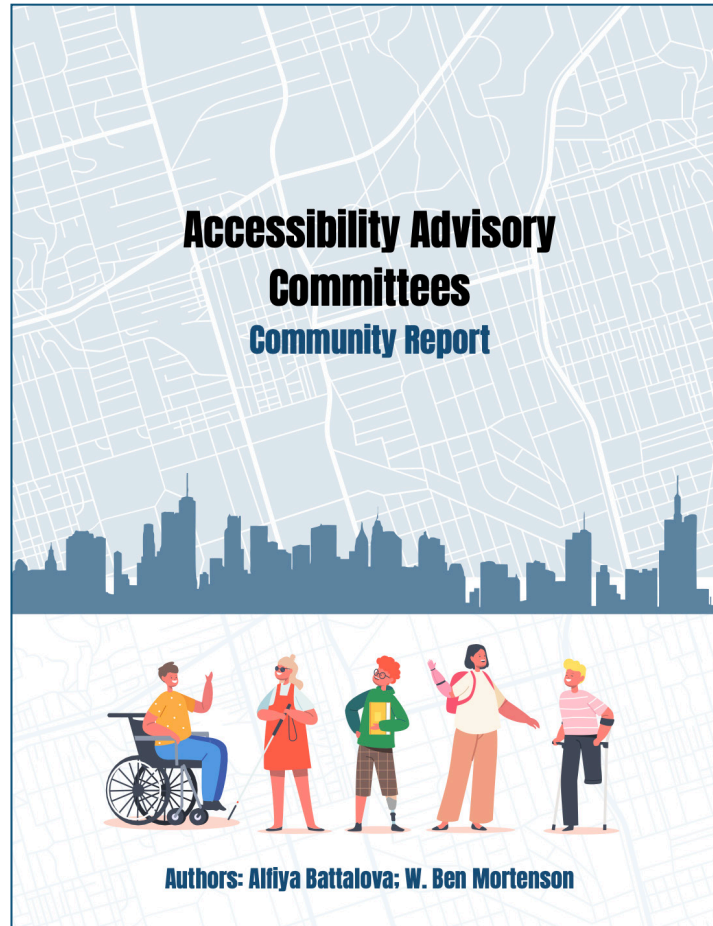
Purpose of the research study
